Your response to a past show where we asked you to tell us about your collecting habits sparked our interest in the reasons why we collect or keep seemingly worthless objects. This has inspired us to bring the Museum of Broken Relationships to Sleaford.

Created in Croatia by Olinka Vištica and Dražen Grubišić, the Museum of Broken Relationships began as a local art installation following the breakup of their own relationship. It is now a permanent museum in Zagreb, as well as a travelling showcase that collects and presents anonymous objects and stories in communities around the world.

Before opening at The National Centre for Craft & Design, the museum will have collected objects from across Lincolnshire donated by local people who have been willing to join the museum and contribute to this tangible emotional history. These objects and their stories will be on display.

All the exhibits displayed strike chords of understanding, healing, and universal connection in all corners of the globe. Contrary to its suggestive title, the Museum is full of hope, life, resilience and inspiration.

The exhibition remains open every day until 15 April 2012.
