

A live musical cinematic experience



Capturing moving images is now commonplace with mobile phones and pocket cameras, but before the digital age it wasn't so easy. Small format movie cameras were the liberating technology of the mid-20th Century, giving ordinary people the chance to record everyday events on their 8mm and 16mm cameras.

Cipher have collaborated with visual artist Anthony Hatton to produce a thought-provoking and engaging visual and live musical experience using unseen footage from the Media Archive for Central England, including local images of Lincolnshire, Derbyshire, West Midlands and Nottinghamshire. The music is composed by renowned musicians Theo Travis (flute, sax - David Sylvian, Robert Fripp, Steven Wilson) and Dave Sturt (fretless bass/sound design - Gong, Steve Hillage, Bill Nelson). They will perform with guest musicians Deirdre Benschik (cello) and Clare Bhabra (violin) from the renowned Sinfonia Viva.
